RAISE is a 5-year expansion grant to scale evidence-based, field-initiated leadership innovations for school enhancement and turnaround for high-needs schools.

AS A RAISE PRINCIPAL RESIDENT YOU WILL:

- Enroll in M.Ed in Educational Administration at TAMU (synchronous online)
- Participate in an evidence-based residency model
- Prepare for principal certification
- Remain in a full-time education role
- Participate in an embedded research study
- Receive a subsidy of up to \$15,000 (\$3000/semester)

PREREQUISITES TO BECOME A RAISE PRINCIPAL RESIDENT:

- Be an established Instructional Coach on K-8 high-needs campuses within a partnering district
- Gain admission into Texas A&M University M.Ed in Educational Administration
- Remain on same campus for the 2 years of RAISE project

M.Ed. in EDUCATIONAL ADMINISTRATION

- 36 hours, 5-semester synchronous online program
 - 3 semesters of enhanced principal residency
- No GRE required, non-thesis degree
- Receive Master's degree and complete course requirements for principal certification in TX

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- Unofficial bachelor's transcript from an accredited university (GPA of 2.5 or higher required)
- Copy of TEA Teacher Certification (w/ TEA ID number)
- Professional Resume/ Curriculum Vitae
- One-Page Statement of Professional Intent/ Career Objective
- 3 letters of professional recommendation (*one of which must be principal recommendation)
- \$89 domestic application fee
